"WillaJory wine takes its name from the 50-million-year-old marine sedimentary Willakenzie and the 20-million-year-old volcanic Jory soils that are renowned in the Willamette Valley and are the foundation of the property. We began developing Erratic Oaks Vineyard almost twenty years ago, and I continue to be awe-struck each year: Beautiful acreage in the Mt. Pisgah sub-AVA of the Willamette Valley, just across the road from the esteemed Freedom Hill Vineyard, but with a slightly warmer Southwest-facing orientation." -Howard Rossbach, Owner

WillaJory Willamette Valley Pinot Gris, sourced entirely from our L.I.V.E certified sustainable Erratic Oaks Vineyard, fully reflects the qualities or terroir of our magnificent site. Sourced from select blocks, the grapes were destemmed then fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks. Only the gentlest techniques were used during the alcohol and ensuing malo-lactic fermentations.

This vibrant Pinot Gris offers exciting aromas of peaches, melon and pears. A wine with rich, yet crisp fruit and lingering finish. Enjoy with all fish, poultry, pasta and pork.
